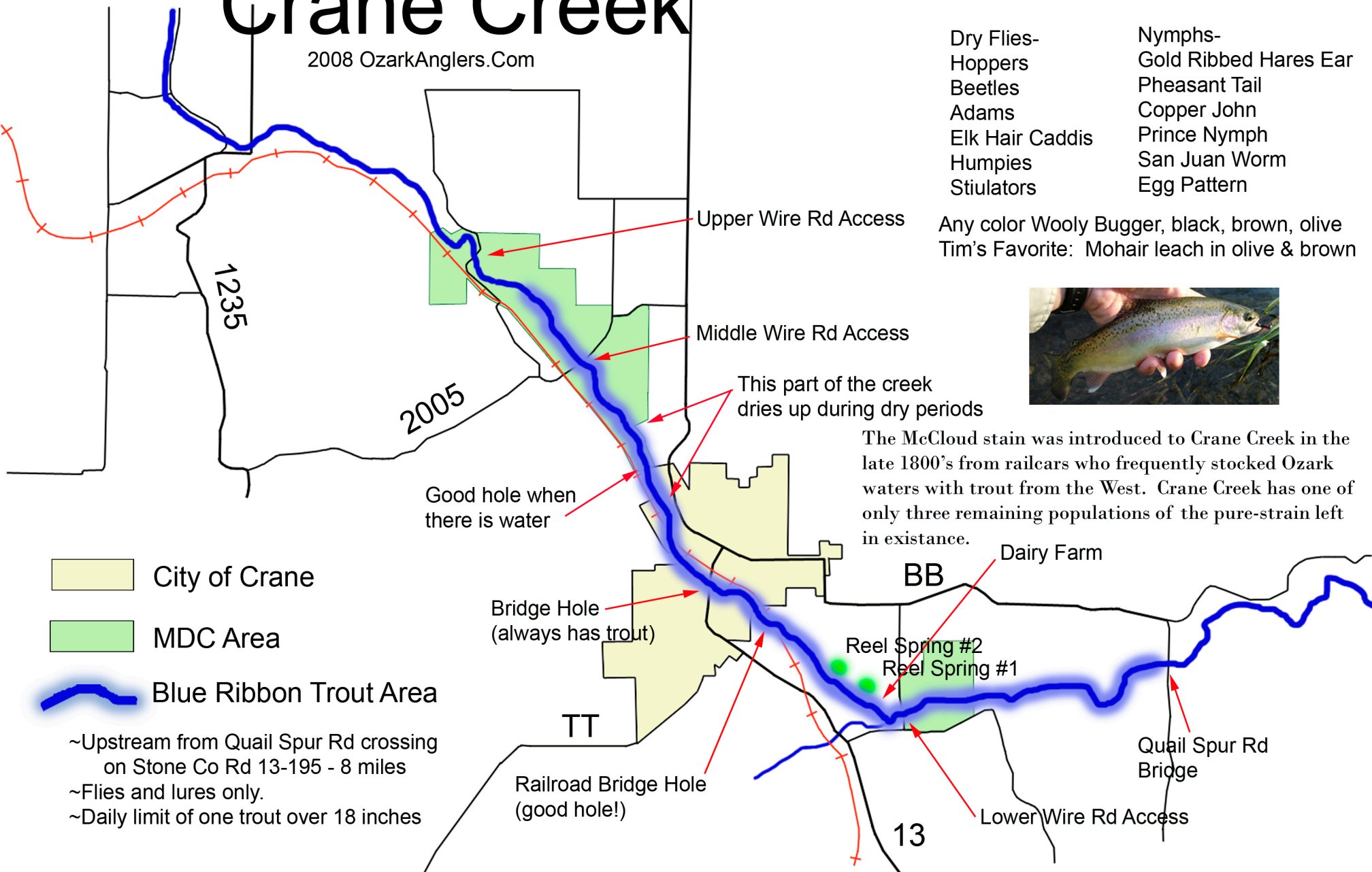



~Flies and lures only.
~Daily limit of one trout over 18 inches

This part of the creek dries up during dry periods

The McCloud stain was introduced to Crane Creek in the late 1800's from railcars who frequently stocked Ozark waters with trout from the West. Crane Creek has one of only three remaining populations of the pure-strain left in existence.
